



That they are each voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, and that they desire and propose that said territory become incorporated as a village pursuant to the laws of Minnesota, to be called "Village of Leonidas." NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Louis County, Minnesota, that said petition for incorporation be and the same is in all things approved and the prayer of said petition is granted, and that an election is hereby called to be held at the town hall of the town of Nichols on the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section thirty-six (36) in township fifty-eight (58) North of Range eighteen (18) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, within the territory above described, on Monday, the 8th day of October, 1917, from nine o'clock in the forenoon to nine o'clock in the afternoon for the determination of the proposed incorporation of the territory above described into a village to be called "Village of Leonidas"; that H. E. Mitchell, R. M. Stephens and William J. Matters, residents of said territory so proposed to be incorporated, are hereby appointed inspectors who shall act as Judges of said election and who shall conduct said election so far as practicable in accordance with the laws regulating an election of town officers.

That the County Auditor of said County cause to be posted in three public places within the boundaries of the territory above described so to be incorporated a copy of the petition hereinbefore referred to with a notice executed by



him attached to said copy of petition, stating the time and place of holding said election, which notices shall be so posted not more than thirty days (30), nor less than twenty (20) days prior to said date for holding said election.
