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ORDINANCE NO. 323

IN THE MATTER OF EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LAND

The Council of the City of Detroit Lakes does ordain:

Section 1: Whereas, the following described real estate
is owned in its entirety by the City of Detroit Lakes:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Section 26, Township 139 North, Range 41 West; thence north along the west line of said Section 26 to the south line of Union Street and the existing city corporate limits line; thence east along the south line of Union Street for a distance of thirty-three (33) feet; thence south and parallel with the west line of said Section 26 to the south line of said Section 26; thence continuing south at a distance of thirty-three (33) feet east of the west line of Section 35, Township 139 North, Range 41 West, to the centerline of the west bound tract of the Northern Pacific Railroad tracks and existing city corporate limits; thence northwesterly along the centerline of the west bound tract to the point of intersection with the west line of said Section 35; and thence north along the west line of said Section 35; to the northwest corner thereof, which is also the southwest corner of said Section 26, also,

Beginning at the northwest corner of the southwest one-quarter of Section 26. Township 139 North, Range 41 West; thence east a distance of thirty-three (33) feet along the north line of the southwest one-quarter of said Section 26, which is also the present city corporate limits line; thence south and parallel with the west line of said Section 26, a distance of two hundred fifty-cight (258) feet to the north line of platted North Street, which is also the present city corporate limits line; thence west along the north line of North Street a distance of thirty-three (33) feet to the west line of said Section 26; and thence north along the west line of said Section 26 to the point of beginning.

Section 2: A hearing was duly held by the governing body, the Council of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, and this proposed Ordinance read on March 1, 1966 and on April 5, 1966.

Section 3: The City Council hereby determines that the annoxation will be in the best interests of the City of Detroit Lakes itself and of the territory affected. That the territory abuts on the City of Detroit Lakes and is owned in its entirety by the said City.

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Section 4: Therefore, the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and
included in the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, as effectually
as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of the County of Becker, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and from and after its passage and publication.
