Extract from By-Laws of the FIDELITY AND DEPOSIT COMPANY OF MARYLAND, adopted by the Stockholders
of said Company on January 19th, 1915.

"Article VI, Section 3--The President, or any of the Vice-Presidents, elected by ballot from the members of the Board of
Directors shall have power by and with the concurrence of the Secretary or any one of the Assistant Secretaries or Additional
Assistant Secretaries, to appoint any attorney-in-fact or to authorize any person or persons to execute on behalf of the
Company any bonds, recognizances, stipulations, undertakings, deeds, releases of mortgages, contracts, agreements, and
policies, and to affix the seal of the Company thereto".

pany, and is still in force.


