

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the number of accidents and highway fatalities is increasing, and

WHEREAS, these accidents with their consequent loss of life, personal injury and property damage is of the utmost concern to the Governor of Minnesota, the State Legislature and other State officials, and

WHEREAS, one important means of reducing the number of accidents now and in the future is by providing adequate driver training instruction and incentive for the young people of the State to become better drivers, and

WHEREAS, the Bloomington Jaycees, as part of an United States Jaycee project being co-sponsored with Lincoln-Mercury Dealers, is hosting the 1966 Minnesota State Teenage Safe Driving Road-E-O, on June 12, 1966,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 6 - 12, 1966, as

"TEENAGE SAFE DRIVING WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens of this State, and particularly the teen-age drivers, to exercise good driving habits so as to make the highways safer for all of the citizens of the State of Minnesota.
