AN ORDINANCE annexing part of Section Thirty-Two (32), Township One Hundred Seven (107), Range Fifteen (15), Olmsted County, Minnesota.

The Village Council of Byron, Minnesota, do ordain that:

Section 1. It being to the best interest of the Village of Byron and the territory affected, the following described premises are hereby annexed to the Village of Byron:



AMENDED PETITION FOR ANNEXATION OF UNPLATTED REAL ESTATE

The undersigned being a majority of the owners in the land hereinafter described, which land abuts upon the present territorial limits of the Village of Byron, hereby petition of Common Concil of the Village of Byron, Minnesota to annex the said land to the Village of Byron.

Land in Olmsted County Minnesota described as follows:

A part of the Northeast Quarter, Southwest Quarter, Section 32, Township 107, Range 15, Olmsted County, Minnesota, described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at a point on the East line of said quarter section which is 330 feet South of the Northeast corner thereof, thence South along the East line a distance of 421.9 feet; thence West at right angles a distance of 833.0 feet thence North at right angles 421.9 feet to a point which is 330 feet South of the North line of said quarter section, thence East and parallel to said quarter section line to the place of beginning.

No part of the land herein described is included in any petition for annexation or incorporation now pending before the Municipal Commission.

No persons now reside within the area to be annexed.

The reason for annexation of this property is to provide existing Municipal services to a proposed residential subdivision.
