An Ordinance Extending the Corporate
Limits of the Village of Ramburg, to
include certain unplatted lands not
exceeding 200 acres

Section 1. - A petition has been filed with the governing body of the Village of Hamburg, Minnesota by Robert W.

Buckentin, Otto Buckentin and Magdalens Buckentin, the owners of and having an interest in the following described real estate to have such lands included within the Village of Hamburg, Minnesota,

Commencing at a point 25% rods North of the Southeast Corner of Section 29. Township 115. North of Range 26 West; thence running North along the Section line between Sections 28 and 29. a distance of 90 feet to a point; which point is the point of beginning of the tract to be herein described; thence continuing North on same line, a distance of 247 feet to a point; thence West, parallel with Section line between Sections 29 and 32, a distance of 165 feet to a point; thence South parallel with Section line between Sections 28 and 29, a distance of 247 feet to a point; thence East parallel with Section line between Sections 29 and 32, a distance of 247 feet to a point; thence East parallel with Section line between Sections 29 and 32, a distance of 255 feet to the place of beginnering.
