Section 1. - A petition having leven filed with the Governing body of the Village of Hamburgby Arthur Buckentin & Magdalena Buckentin , Can owners of the follow ing described real estate to have such lands included within the Villago of Mamburg, Minnesota:

That part of the Mortheast Quarter of the Northeast quartor of Section 32. Township 115. Range 26, described as follows: Commencing at a point on the North line of said Section at a distance of 253.5 feet West of the Mortheast Corner, of said Section, which daid point is the point of beginning of this description; thence running West on the Worth line of said Section 32. a distance of 100 feet to a point; thence turning and running South parallel to the Section line between Sections 32 and 33. a distance of 260 feet to a point; thence turning and running Rest parallel to the North line of said Section 32, a distance of 353.50 feet to a point on the Bost line of said Section 32; thence turning and running Worth along the Ext line of said Section 32. a distance of 45.5 feet to a point; thence turning and running West parallel to the Worth line of said Section 32, a distance of 253.5 feet to a point; thence turning and running North parallel to the East line of said Section 32, a distance of 214.5 feet to the place of beginning.
