

PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF VILLAGE OF DELLEWOOD.

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY:

The undersigned, who are voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, petition the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Minnesota, to call an election for the determination of the proposed incorporation as a village of the territory hereinafter described.

1. The boundaries of the territory to be included in such incorporated village are as follows:

Commencing on the northerly shore of White Bear Lake where the boundary line between the County of Washington and the County of Ramsey intersects the shore of said lake; thence north along said county line to the northerly boundary line of the Stillwater Road; thence southeasterly along the northerly boundary line of said Stillwater Road to the westerly boundary line of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter (E₁ SE₁) of Section Seven (7), Township Thirty (30) North of Range Twenty-one (21) West; thence north along said last named boundary line to the northeast corner of said East Half of the Southeast Quarter (E₁ SE₁) of said Section Seven (7); thence east along the quarter-section line to the northeast corner of said East Half of the Southeast Quarter (E₁ SE₁) of said Section Seven (7); thence south along the east boundary line of said Section Seven (7) to a point 1070.3 feet north of the southeast corner of said section; thence north Fifty degrees (50°) and Fifty minutes (50') east 414.1 feet to an iron monument; thence south Fifty-five degrees (55°) and Forty minutes (40') east 138.66 feet to an iron monument; thence south Thirty-one degrees (31°) and Fifty-three minutes (53') west 478.15 feet to an iron monument; thence south thirty degrees (30°) and forty-five minutes (45') east 176.05 feet to an iron monument; thence south Twenty degrees (20°) and Forty-six minutes (46') west 331.1 feet to an iron monument; thence south Sixteen degrees (16°) and fifty-nine minutes (59') west 878.37 feet to an iron monument; thence south Sixteen degrees (16°) and Thirty-two minutes (32') west 120.35 feet to an iron monument on the south line of Section Eight (8), Township Thirty (30) North of Range Twenty-one (21) West; thence south Thirty-three degrees (33°) and Twenty-four minutes (24') west 67.73 feet to a point on the east boundary line of Section Eighteen (18) of said Township and Range; thence south along said last named section line to the northerly boundary line of the Stillwater Road; thence easterly along the northerly boundary line of said Stillwater Road to the point where said northerly boundary line intersects the westerly boundary line of Vincent Street as the same was layed out in the plat of Dellewood; thence southwesterly along the westerly line of said Vin-

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cent Street to the southerly boundary line of Maryland Street in the plat of Wildwood; thence along the southerly boundary line of said Maryland Street to the northwesterly corner of Block One Hundred Twenty-six (126) of Wildwood; thence south along the westerly boundary line of said Block One Hundred Twenty-six (126) of Wildwood and said line produced to the most northerly corner of Block One Hundred Thirty (130) of Wildwood; thence southwesterly along the southeasterly boundary line of Magnolia Avenue and said line produced to the southwesterly boundary line of the right of way of the Stillwater Branch of the Northern Pacific Railway Company, being the northeasterly boundary of Grove Park according to the recorded plat thereof; thence southeasterly along said northeasterly boundary line of Grove Park to the southeasterly corner of Grove Park; thence westerly along the southerly line of Grove Park to the shore of White Bear Lake; thence northwesterly along the shore of White Bear Lake and following the contours thereof to the point of beginning; all of the property included within said boundaries being in the County of Washington and State of Minnesota;

3. An accurate census of the resident population within the boundaries of said territory was taken on the 18th and 19th days of June, 1917, and within eight (8) weeks prior to the presentation of this petition, and the number of actual residents in the territory above described was and is two
hundred and seventy four.

3. The name proposed for said village is "Village of Dellwood."

4. No part of the above described territory is in any incorporated city or village. The greater part of the territory above described has been platted into lots and blocks by plats which have been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the State and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Washington County, and said territory contains a resident population of not more than three thousand (3,000) nor less than two hundred (200). Such part of said territory as is unplattead adjoins the platted portion thereof and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government. The quantity of land embraced in the territory above described is six hundred and twenty four acres.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned respectfully petition
the County Board of said Washington County to call an election
for the determination of the proposed incorporation of the
Village of Dellwood.

WHEREAS, at a special meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Minnesota, duly called and held at the City of Stillwater in said County on the 20th day of June, 1917, a petition signed by Samuel G. Ordway, William D. Mitchell and others was duly presented to the Board, proposing the organization of a village within the boundaries of said Washington County to be known as "Village of Dellwood", and it appearing to the Board that said petition is in the form and has been executed and verified in a manner provided by law,

RESOLVED, that an election be and the same hereby is called for the determination of said proposed incorporation; that said election shall be held and conducted at the Dellwood Station of the Northern Pacific Railway Company in the County of Washington, Minnesota, on Thursday, the 13th day of July, 1917, commencing at 9:00 A.M., and the same shall be conducted so far as practicable in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers.

are hereby appointed inspectors to act as judges of said election.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that not less than twenty (20) days prior to the date herein fixed for said election copies of said petition for incorporation, with a notice attached stating the time and place for holding such election as above fixed, shall be posted in three public places within the boundaries described in said petition, to-wit: One at the Dellwood Station, one at the Clubhouse Station and one at the Peninsula Station of the Northern Pacific Railway Company.
