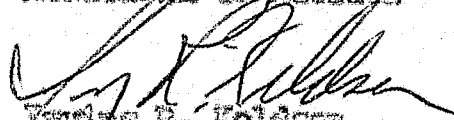
The Municipal Commission acknowledges receipt of your Ord. No. 100 and filing fees and finds that all the requirements of the Commission Act have been met.

ORDINANCE NO. 100

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF FOLEY TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND AND UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ADJUTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated April 10th, 1900, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 3rd day of May, 1900; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 49 acres of platted and unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by the owner; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the southeast boundary thereof;

The Council of the Village of Foley, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the platted and unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Commencing at the intersection of the South line of the Great Northern Railway Right-of-way with the East Right-of-way line of Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 25; thence Southerly along said East Right-of-way line of Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 25 to the Northwest corner of Lot Eighteen (18), Block One (1), Foley Development Plat, being part of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Thirty-seven (37) North, Range Twenty-nine (29), West; thence Easterly a distance of 160.19 feet; thence Northerly a distance of 132 feet; thence Westerly a distance of 160.19 feet; thence northerly and parallel with the first described line to the intersection of the South line of the Great Northern Railroad Right-of-way and there terminating, and

Blocks One (1), Two (2), Three (3) Five (5) and Six (6), and Lots Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Fifteen (15), Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17), Eighteen (18), Nineteen (19), Twenty (20), Twenty-one (21) and Twenty-two (22), of Block Four (4), Foley Development Plat, all of which is in the name of Foley Business Development Corporation, a Minnesota corporation.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
