## ORDINANCE NO. 89

An Ordinance Annexing a Certain Tract of Land to the Village of Lamberton, Redwood County, Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of Lamberton, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

## Section 1, Annexation.

The following tract of land lying and being in the County of Redwood and State of Minnesota, and abutting upon the corporate limits of the said Village of Lamberton, particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point where the North line of Fifth Street in the Village of Lamberton, Minnesota, extending Easterly intersects the center line of Section Twenty-three (23), Township One Hundred Nine (109) North, of Range Thirtyseven (37), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, running thence Easterly along the North line of said Fifth Street as so extended, to a point six hundred (600) feet due East of said center line of Section Twenty-three (23), thence due South and parallel with said center line of said Section Twenty-three (23) and six hundred (600) feet distant therefrom, to a point on the North line of the public road extending Easterly as established and laid out along the Southerly boundary line of the said Village of Lamberton, thence Westerly along the North line of said public road six hundred (600) feet to said center line, thence Northerly along said center line to the point of beginning, containing twenty-three and thirty-seven one-hundredths (23.37) acres, more or less, according to the Survey thereof.

is hereby annexed to and made a part of the Village of Lamberton, Redwood County, Minnesota, as fully and for all purposes as if originally a part thereof.

Section 2. Liability for Debts.

The aforesaid tract of land shall be liable for all general bonded indebtedness of the said Village of Lamberton in the same manner as all other lands within said Village of Lamberton.

## Section 3. Taxation.

The aforesaid tract of land shall be subject to and liable for all general and special taxes assessed and levied in said Village of Lamberton in the year of 1966 and thereafter.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
