
Dear Mr. Kearney:

ORDINANCE NO. 69
AN ORDINANCE FOR ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY

The Village Council of the Village of Savage do ordain:

WHEREAS, it appears that a due and proper Petition for the Annexation of certain real property to the Village of Savage, signed by all the owners of the land proposed to be annexed, which land does not exceed 200 acres, has been properly presented to this Body, and

WHEREAS, the proper notices pursuant to Chapter 899 of the laws of 1965, have been served and M.S.A. Section 414 et seq. has been properly complied with and due notice has been served on the Scott County Board of Commissioners, and upon the Board of Supervisors of Glendale Township of Scott County, and

WHEREAS, either said Bodies have consented or no written objections were submitted by the said boards, and

WHEREAS, the Village Council having duly studied all matters covered by the Petition,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Council of the Village of Savage does hereby find that it is in the best interests of the Village of Savage, and of the territory to be annexed, that it be annexed, and

The Village Council of the Village of Savage does hereby annex to the Village of Savage, the following described property:

That part of Government Lot 5, section 9, township 115 north, range 21 west, Scott County, Minnesota; which lied northwesterly of a line run parallel with and distant 300 feet southeasterly of the first following described line and southeasterly of a line run parallel with and distant 300 feet southeasterly of the second following described line:

Line 1. Beginning at a point on the south line of section B. township 115 north, range 21 west, distant 59.1 feet west of the southeast corner thereof; thence run northeasterly at an angle of 59°41' with said south section line for 572.7 feet; thence deflect to the right on a 4°00' curve (delta angle 61°14') for 1430.8 feet; thence on tangent to said curve for 100 feet and there terminating;

Line 2. From the point of termination of line 1 described above, run westerly along said line for 100 feet; thence deflect to the left on a 4°00' curve (delta angle 11°53'30") for 297.3 feet to the point of beginning of the line to be described; thence on tangent to said curve for 1300 feet and there terminating;

Containing 8.80 acres, more or less.

which property is all of said Government Lot 5 not previously a part of the Village of Savage and lying southerly of State Trunk Highway 101 and 13 in said section.

George E. Roberts being duly sworn, on oath says; that he is, and during all the times herein stated has been the co-publisher of the Corporation, the publisher of the newspaper known as The Shakopee Valley News, and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated;

That immediately prior to the publication therein of the printed Ordinance No. 69 hereto attached, said newspaper was printed and published in the City of Shakopee, in the County of Scott, State of Minnesota on Thursday of each week; that during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the City of Shakopee from which it purports to be issued as above stated in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least 450 running inches of single column, two inches wide; has been issued once each week from a known office established in said place of publication and employing skilled workmen and equipped with the necessary material for preparing and printing the same, and the presswork on that part of the newspaper devoted to local news of the community which it purports to serve, was done in its known office of publication;

That during all said time in its makeup not less than twenty-five per cent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve, that during all said time it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and has not been entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements; has been circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local postoffice; that the said newspaper was in existence but publication thereof was suspended before the completion of one full year because the editor or publisher entered active military service after December 7, 1941, and prior to December 31, 1946, under the Selective Service Act of 1940, and publication of the newspaper was resumed after honorable discharge of the editor or publisher; and that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Scott County, Minnesota the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper; and that there has been a copy of each issue, filed with the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota.
