P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, the American Water Works Association, which is dedicated to advancing the knowledge of design, operation, and management of water utilities throughout the United States and Canada, has asked that a special period be designated during which each water utility will bring its message to the people, and

WHEREAS, we are dependent for our health, comfort and standard of living upon the continuing flow of safe, quality water in amounts sufficient to serve all our needs and provide for the vital economic growth of our community, and

WHEREAS, it is important that the people of this state become aware of the needs of the public water system, and the tasks that face it in the future, and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of August 14, 1966, as

"PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY WEEK"

and urge all citizens to join in developing a wider understanding of the contributions, the services, and the future needs of the public water systems of our state and nation.
