

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the well-being of citizens of this state depend upon the health of its economy, and

WHEREAS, the principle of freedom of enterprise is the basis of our economy and provides the chief impetus for its growth and stability, and

WHEREAS, better understanding of freedom of enterprise by the people of this state would be conducive to the preservation and strengthening of our free economy,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of August 28 to September 3, 1966, as

"FREEDOM OF ENTERPRISE WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge our citizens of all ages to acquaint themselves with the principles of freedom of enterprise, and to avail themselves of the special opportunities provided during the observance by Kiwanis clubs in their communities, in order to gain a renewed understanding of, and appreciation for, our free economy to the end that it may be defended, strengthened, and perpetuated.
