- WHEREAS, the reckless operation of motor vehicles, whether by design or habit, or as a result of mental preoccupation, has in the main created this problem that is sacrificing our human resources, and
- WHEREAS, the total attack to remedy this serious problem or to reduce its impact must involve the call of resources beyond those of education, enforcement, engineering, and legislation, and
- WHEREAS, the saving of lives is the responsibility of every citizen of the State of Minnesota, and in order to effectively combat this problem he must be informed and educated,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 25 through July 2, as


"TRAFFIC SAFETY WEEK"


