PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Paul Alar and Peter Trepich were, on or about November 15, 1917, murdered in the County of Saint Louis in the State of Minnesota; and,

WHEREAS, the murderers of the said Mr. and Mrs. Paul Alar and Peter Trepich have not been apprehended and the public welfare requires their capture, conviction and punishment for said offense;

NOW THEREFORE, I, J.A.A. Burnquist, Governor of the State of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the Treasury of the State the sum of FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS for the arrest and conviction or for information leading to the arrest of the murderers of the said Mr. and Mrs. Paul Alar and Peter Trepich.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereto caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed and have hereunto set my hand at the Capitol in the city of Saint Paul, this 26th day of November, 1917.

Whereas Christian Kortgaard has an inchoate interest in said lands as the husband of said Franziska Kortgaard; and

Whereas Andreas Ueland resides in the City of Minneapolis, County of Hennepin and State of Minnesota, and said Franziska Kortgaard and Christian Kortgaard desire to appoint him resident agent in said State of Minnesota in accordance with the provisions of §8023 General Statutes of Minnesota for 1913;

Now, therefore, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the said Franziska Kortgaard and Christian Kortgaard, her husband, do hereby make, constitute and appoint the said Andreas Ueland our agent to accept service of process or summons in any action or proceeding in the State of Minnesota concerning our aforesaid interest respectively in lands in said state, and we hereby consent that service of process or summons upon the said Andreas Ueland shall be binding upon each and both of us.
