AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN BOUNDARIES TO THE CITY OF WACON, MINNESOTA.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WACON DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. WHEREAS, all of the owners of all of the property described hereinafter have petitioned the Common Council of the City of Wacon to have said property annexed to the City of Wacon, said property lying and being in the County of Wacon and State of Minnesota, described as follows, viz:

The Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (1/4 of 1/4) of Section Twenty-four (27), Township One Hundred Seven (107) North, Range Twenty-Two (22) West, except commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (1/4 of 1/4), Section Twenty-four (27), Township One Hundred Seven (107) North, Range Twenty-Two (22), intersecting first said point in the center of Rural Highway No. Thirteen (13), as presently located; thence in a Northerly direction a distance of 50 feet to the North Line of said Rural Highway No. Thirteen (13) as presently located as the point of commencement; thence in a Northerly direction 210 feet thence in a Northerly direction 750 feet thence in a Northerly direction 300 feet to the South Line of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (1/4 of 1/4) thence in a Northerly direction a distance of 750 feet thence in a northerly direction a distance of 50 feet to the point of beginning, subject to Highway Rights-of-Way, and excepting also, commencing at a point 525 feet south of the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (1/4 of 1/4) thence West 125 feet thence South 375 feet thence East 125 feet thence North 375 feet to the point of beginning subject to Highway Rights-of-Way excepting also, the North 50 feet of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (1/4 of 1/4).

AND WHEREAS, it has been shown that all of the land above described is contiguous and adjacent to the present corporate limits of the City of Wacon, that said land is not platted and contains less than the required statutory minimum of 500 acres, and does contain 38 acres, more or less;

AND WHEREAS, notice of the petition of said owners has duly been given to the Minnesota Municipalities Commission, the Wacon City Board, and the Wacon County Board, and that no other governing body of any other municipality along the boundaries of said land to be so annexed, and whereupon more than thirty days has expired without notice of objection to the annexation of said lands having been filed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WACON,

SECTION 1, pursuant to the authority and provisions of Section 401,403, Subdivision 2, Minnesota Statutes annotated, and other pertinent laws of the state of Minnesota;

SECTION 2. That said real estate described hereinbefore, he, and the same hereby is, annexed to the City of Wacon, Minnesota.

SECTION 3. That a duly certified copy of this ordinance shall be filed in the following offices:

- a. Office of the Minnesota Municipalities Commission
- b. Office of the Secretary of State of Minnesota
- c. Office of the Wacon County Auditor
- d. Office of the Wacon County Register of Deeds

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in accordance with law and approval thereof by the authority aforesaid.
