ORDINANCE NO. 353

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS TO THE CITY OF WASSON, MINNESOTA.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASSON DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. BEAVER, all of the owners of all of the property described hereinafter have petitioned the Common Council of the City of Wasson to have said property annexed to the City of Wasson, said property lying and being in the County of Wasson and State of Minnesota, described as follows, viz:

The southeast quarter of the southwest quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section seventeen (17), Township One Hundred seven (107) North, Range Twenty Two (22) East, except commencing at the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section seventeen (17), Township One Hundred seven (107) North, Range Twenty-two (22), including first said point to in the corner of Trunk Highway No. thirteen (13), as presently located; thence in a northerly direction a distance of 50 feet to the North line of said Trunk Highway No. thirteen (13) as presently located as the point of commencement; thence in a northerly direction 210 feet thence in an easterly direction 750 feet thence in a southerly direction 200 feet to the South line of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) thence in a easterly direction a distance of 700 feet thence in a southerly direction a distance of 50 feet to the point of beginning. Subject to Highway Easements, and excepting also, commencing at a point 500 feet south of the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) thence West 100 feet thence South 375 feet thence East 100 feet thence North 375 feet to the point of beginning subject to Highway Easements excepting also, the North 50 feet of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$).

AND WHEREAS, it has been shown that all of the land above described is contiguous and adjacent to the present corporate limits of the City of Wasson, that said land is not platted and contains less than the required statutory maximum of 360 acres, and does contain 55 acres, more or less;

AND WHEREAS, notice of the petition of said owners has duly been given to the Minnesota Municipalities Commission, the Hennepin Land Board, and the Wasson County Board, and that no other governing body of any other municipality claims the boundaries of said land to be so situated, and whereas more than thirty days has expired without notice of objection to the annexation of said lands having been filed,

AND, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASSON, MINNESOTA, pursuant to the authority and provisions of Section 424.03, Subdivision 2, Minnesota Statutes Annotated, and other pertinent laws of the State of Minnesota;

SECTION 2. That said real estate described hereinafore, be, and the same hereby is, annexed to the City of Wasson, Minnesota.

SECTION 3. That a duly certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed in the following offices:

- a. Office of the Minnesota Municipalities Commission
- b. Office of the Secretary of State of Minnesota
- c. Office of the Wasson County Auditor
- d. Office of the Wasson County Register of Deeds

That said Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in accordance with law and approval thereof pursuant to the statutes above cited.
