AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNITATION LAND NOT EXCEEDING THE HUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Ection 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota by the sole owners of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

All that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW1NW1) of Section Ten (10), Township One Hundred Eleven (111) North, Range Forty-one (11) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Lyon County, Minnesota, described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the westerly line of Section Ten (10), Township One Hundred Eleven (111) North, Hange Forty-one (11) West, with the northerly line of F Street in Nuese Addition, City of Marshall, Minnesota; thence easterly along the northerly line of said F Street a distance of 125 feet; thence northerly and parallel with the westerly line of said Section 10 a distance of 100 feet; thence westerly and parallel with the northerly line of said F Street a distance of 125 feet to the westerly line of said Section 10; thence southerly along the westerly line of said Section 10 a distance of 100 feet to the place of beginning and containing 0.29 acres more or less.
