
IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF THE CITY OF WADSWATER FOR THE

REASON

The petition lacks a census list as required by Minn. Stat. 3363,  
Sec. 41.43, subd. 1, and 41.44, subd. 1. The Commission recognizes  
the difficulty of obtaining a census in this case and will recommend  
that the legislature amend this requirement to allow a federal census  
taken within one year of the date of the petition or the latest ac-  
ceptable planning commission estimate of the population in the area  
to substitute for an actual census. As presently worded, the statute  
requires that a census list be attached to the petition and the Commis-  
sion is without power to waive this requirement or accept substitution.  
The petition does not meet the statutory requirements and therefore  
must be dismissed.
