WHEREAS, the preservation and encouragement of the accordion, both as an educational and recreational instrument is one of the paramount aims of the Minnesota Accordion Guild; and

WHEREAS, elevating the ethical and cultural standards of those interested in the accordion as a student, teacher, studio operator and collector is an on-going project; and

WHEREAS, in carrying on this program, the Minnesota Accordion Guild is sponsoring a State Festival in Minneapolis on August 27 and 28, 1966; and

WHEREAS, over 600 contestants have enrolled in the various categories coming from every corner of the State of Minnesota;

Now, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Palvay, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 27 and 28, 1966, as

"ACCORDION DAY"

In Minnesota, and to urge all citizens to enjoy and appreciate the music and the efforts of the Minnesota Accordion Guild.
