CERTIFICATE BY VILLAGE COUNCIL TO COUNTY AUDITOR OF SPECIAL ELECTION.

We do hereby certify and return that at a special Village Election at the Frazer Hotel in said Village of Trommald in the County of Crow Wing, State of Minnesota, duly called and held pursuant to law, on the 8th day of December, 1917, to vote on the question of whether said Village of Trommald should become a separate election and a separate assessment district from the organized Towns of Wolford and Klondike, Crow Wing County, Minnesota, the said Townships being the Townships in which said incorporated Village of Trommald lies :

The following number of votes were cast for and against said proposition, towit :

For separation, twenty-two (22) votes.

Against separation, none.
