
Dear Mr. Penco:

ORDINANCE NO. 17

N-782

IN THE MATTER OF THE ANNEXATION OF A TRACT OF
REAL ESTATE

The Village Council of Geneva, Minnesota does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.

Proceedings have been held herein for the purpose of annexing the following described tract of real estate:

Commencing at the Southeast Corner of Lot Nine (9), Block Ninety-Nine (99), Village of Geneva, Freeborn County, State of Minnesota, thence East One Hundred Ninety-Seven (197) feet, thence South Two Hundred Thirty (230) feet, thence West One Hundred Ninety-Seven (197) feet, thence North Two Hundred Thirty (230) feet to point of beginning, all being a portion of the following:

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of Government Lot 1, Section Eight (8), Township One Hundred Four (104), Range Twenty (20) thence East along the section line 1/4 2/7 rods, thence North 112 rods to center of highway, thence West 1/4 2/7 rods to the West line of the NE 1/4-SW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 104, Range 20, thence South along such quarter line 112 rods to the place of beginning, being the Southwest Corner of Government Lot 1, Section 8, Township 104, Range 20, containing 10 acres, subject to the public highway above mentioned and being a piece of land 1/4 2/7 rods East and West and 112 rods North and South of the West side of Government Lot 1 and that part of the NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 lying from the center of road above mentioned South to Government Lot 1, all in Township 104, Range 20, Freeborn County, Minnesota.

SECTION 2.

It is found that the annexation of the tract of real estate described is in the best interest of the Village of Geneva.

SECTION 3.

An easement to the city is retained for purposes of sewage, water, electrical power and telephone service connections.

SECTION 4.

The petition for annexation of the real estate was read and heard on the 5th of April, 1965.

SECTION 5.

The ordinance was introduced, read, and passed at a regular meeting of the Village on May 3, 1966. The following votes were in favor of the ordinance:
