ORDINANCE NO. 393

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIBRAYS OF THE CITY OF INVATORNA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TUPLATTED LAND ABITTING COON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain polition dated and retarized May 11, 1966, requesting annexation of the territory hereitafter described was duly presented to the council on the 17th day of Hay . 1966; and

THRUNS, the quantity of and embraced within the area described in the petition and best-fed as described in 25-05 acres, more or less, of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all of the owners of said land, except to the highway right of way and railroad right-of-way contained within said legal description;

WHEREAS, no objections to the arresation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be arresed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits at the South boundary thereof established by City Ordinarce 388 of the City of Owstonna, which said Ordinarce annexed abutting land to the City of Owstonna, Minnesota; and

WIRRAL, it is deemed to be to the best interest to the land effected and the City of Owstonna that the railroad right of way and the highway right-of-way hereinafter described be annexed to and made a part of the City of Owstonna,

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Owntonna do ordains

The City Courc'll hereby determinent Section 1.

(1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the city and of the territory affected.

(2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is, or is about to become, urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits

of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Township 107 North, Range 20 West, Steale County, Minnesota; thence North 830 35; Fast for 142 feet; thence North 10 55; Mest for 35 feet; thence North 880 35; East for 25 feet, thence North 10 55; West for 200 feet; thence South 880 35; West for 167 feet; thence South 10 55; East for 235 feet to the point of beginning.

Section J. Filing. The City Clark is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and filing of the partified copies as directed in Section 3.
