
Dear Mr. Haberman:

ORDINANCE NO. 393

A-1027 8-9-66

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LANDS ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated and returned May 11, 1966, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 17th day of May, 1966; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 25.05 acres, more or less, of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all of the owners of said land, except to the highway right-of-way and railroad right-of-way contained within said legal description; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits at the South boundary thereof established by City Ordinance 388 of the City of Owatonna, which said Ordinance annexed abutting land to the City of Owatonna, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be to the best interest to the land effected and the City of Owatonna that the railroad right-of-way and the highway right-of-way hereinafter described be annexed to and made a part of the City of Owatonna.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Owatonna do ordain:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines:

- (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the city and of the territory affected;
- (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is, or is about to become, urban or suburban in character; and
- (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The South 50 feet of the Southeast Quarter of Section Five, Township One Hundred Seven North, Range Twenty West,  
and  
The Northeast Quarter of Section Eight, Township One Hundred Seven North, Range Twenty West,  
and

Commencing at a point 332 feet west and 50 feet north of the Southeast corner of Section Five, Township 107 North, Range 20 West, Steale County, Minnesota; thence North 88° 35' East for 142 feet; thence North 1° 55' West for 35 feet; thence North 88° 35' East for 25 feet; thence North 1° 55' West for 200 feet; thence South 88° 35' West for 167 feet; thence South 1° 55' East for 235 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.

Passed and adopted this 7th day of June, 1966, with the following vote: Ayes 7; Noes 0; Absent and not voting 0.



ORDINANCE NO. 1084

EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ADJUTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain Petition dated April 14, 1966, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Common Council of the City of Austin on the 6th day of June, 1966,

AND WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is 1.82 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough,

AND WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all of the owners,

AND WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed,

AND WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts the City limits at the West boundary thereof,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1: The Common Council determines that the annexation will be the best interest of the City and of the territory affected.

SECTION 2: That the territory described herein abuts the City limits and is about to become urban or suburban in character; and that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

SECTION 3: The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The North 113.43 feet (measured along the east line) of the following described tract of land: Starting at the SE corner of the  $N\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section No. 4, Township 102 North, Range 13 West; thence 1,532.32 ft. West along the South line of the said  $N\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and to the point of beginning of the Tract to be described; thence continuing West 381.49 Ft. along the said South line of the  $N\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and to the Southwest corner of the tract being described, said Southwest corner being at a point in the centerline in and near the center of Turtle Creek; thence Northeasterly 196.49 Ft. at a deflection angle of 103° 06' 45" Rt. and
