
Dear Mr. Patton:

ORDINANCE NO. 120

An ordinance annexing certain territory therein described to the Village of New Richmond, Minnesota.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW RICHMOND, MINNESOTA, DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1: WHEREAS, the owners of the tract, parcel and piece of land abutting upon or contiguous to the corporate limits of the Village of New Richmond, hereinafter described, have petitioned the Common Council of the Village of New Richmond, Minnesota to have the following described property situated in the County of Wagon and State of Minnesota, annexed to the Village of New Richmond, to-wit:

Lots Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8) and Nine (9) all in Block Seven (7) in Zieger's Subdivision in the East One-Half (1/2) of the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4) Section Seventeen (17), Township One Hundred Five (105) North Range Twenty-Two (N. 22), together with the South One-Half (S1/2) of Langdon Street from the extended West line of said Lot Four (4) to the center line of St. Thomas Street; and together with the North One-Half (N1/2) of Hillsbury Street from the extended West line of said Lot Nine (9) to the center line of St. Thomas Street; together with the East One-Half (E1/2) of St. Thomas Street from the center line of Langdon Street to the center line of Hillsbury Street, all being in the said Zieger's Subdivision.

WHEREAS, The Petitioners are all of the owners of said property and the owners adjacent to the streets therein named, and whereas the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of New Richmond and the territory affected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW RICHMOND, MINNESOTA, Pursuant to the authority and provisions of Minnesota Statutes Annotated, Section 414.03, Subd. 2:

Section 2. That the property hereinafore described be and the same hereby is annexed to the Village of New Richmond, Minnesota.

Section 3. IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED AND ORDERED, That a duly certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, of Wagon County, Minnesota.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication, and other filings required by the above cited statute.


