
Dear Mr. Patton:

ORDINANCE NO. 120

An ordinance ordering certain territory therein described to the Village of New Richland, Minnesota.

* * * * *

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW RICHLAND, MINNESOTA, DO GREET:

SECTION 1: WHEREAS, the owners of the tract, parcel and piece of land abutting upon or contiguous to the corporate limits of the Village of New Richland, hereinbefore described, have petitioned the Common Council of the Village of New Richland, Minnesota to have the following described property situate in the County of Wanona and State of Minnesota, annexed to the Village of New Richland, to-wit:

Lots Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8) and Nine (9) all in Block Seven (7) in Sieger's Subdivision in the East One-Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section Seventeen (17), Township One Hundred Five (105) North Range Twenty-Two (R. 22), together with the South One-Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Langdon Street from the extended West line of said Lot Four (4) to the center line of St. Thomas Street; and together with the North One-Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Pillsbury Street from the extended East line of said Lot Nine (9) to the center line of St. Thomas Street; together with the West One-Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of St. Thomas Street from the center line of Langdon Street to the center line of Pillsbury Street, all being in the said Sieger's Subdivision.

WHEREAS, The Petitioners are all of the owners of said property and the owners adjacent to the streets herein named, and wherein the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of New Richland and the territory affected;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW RICHLAND, MINNESOTA, Pursuant to the authority and provisions of Minnesota Statutes Annotated, Section 414.03, Subd. 8;

Section 2. That the property hereinbefore described be and the same hereby is annexed to the Village of New Richland, Minnesota.

Section 3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ORDAINED, That a duly certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, of Wanona County, Minnesota.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication, and other filings required by the above cited statute.
