

REPORT OF MINNESOTA VOTING MACHINE
COMMISSION MADE SEPTEMBER 5, 1966,
ON THE LICENSING OF THE HARRIS IBM
VOTOMATIC SYSTEM FOR EXPERIMENTAL USE



The Minnesota Voting Machine Commission has licensed the HARRIS IBM VOTOMATIC SYSTEM for experimental use in all precincts in the City of Coon Rapids, Minnesota for the state primary election to be held September 13, 1966.

It is the opinion of the Commission that the extension of the experiment to the primary election will greatly assist the Commission in its ultimate evaluation.

It is the opinion of the Commission that the license for the use of the HARRIS IBM VOTOMATIC SYSTEM by Coon Rapids, Minnesota in that election complies with the conditions prescribed by L. 1965, c. 619 and by all other pertinent laws of the State of Minnesota, and is therefore approved.
