

PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, the active participation of individual homeowners is of singular importance to the President's program to beautify America, and
- WHEREAS, the American homeowner's interest in American beautification must be kept at its highest interest throughout the year to take full advantage of all available natural beauty, and
- WHEREAS, the planting of townscapes, landscapes, and individual home grounds must be a continuing endeavor at proper planting seasons, and
- WHEREAS, fall is the ideal time for creating more colorful spring gardens through planting trees, shrubs, grass, and flower bulbs,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 2 - 8, 1966, as

"SPRING GARDEN PLANTING WEEK"

In Minnesota and urge the people of Minnesota to join in appropriate activities to make a more beautiful America.
