

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL ESTATE TO  
THE VILLAGE OF TYLER, MINNESOTA

The Village Council of the Village of Tyler does ordain as follows:

1. That the sole owner of real estate hereinafter described has petitioned the Village Council to annex to and incorporate said land in the Village of Tyler, Minnesota.
2. That said land is platted and abuts on said Village of Tyler.
3. That it is for the best interest of all concerned that said land be so annexed to the Village of Tyler, Minnesota.
4. That the real estate lying and being in the County of Lincoln, and State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

The South 60 feet of the North 120 feet of Lot Four (4), Block One (1) of Danebod Addition in Section Numbered Ten (10), Township Numbered One Hundred Nine (109) North, of Range Numbered Forty-four (44) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Lincoln County, Minnesota, as said Lot is laid down and described on the plat of said addition on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County and State.

be, and the same hereby is annexed to and incorporated in the Village of Tyler, Minnesota.

5. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication and upon filing of a copy of said ordinance with the Municipalities Commission of the State of Minnesota, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor of the County of Lincoln, Minnesota.

Councilman Thomsen seconded the motion, and upon being put to a vote, the same was adopted unanimously.
