WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service is the messenger and servant of all the people, and

WHEREAS, the Postal Service is dependant for its proper functioning upon the skill and training of local postal employees, and

WHEREAS, by their devotion to duty, their loyalty and their integrity postal employees have earned the respect and admiration of citizens of Minnesota,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvas, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 16 - 22, 1966, as

"POSTAL EMPLOYEE WEEK"

and call upon all citizens of this state to join me in the observance of that week.
