

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, every year millions of motorists find that the worn-out automobile battery that worked fine in the summer months fails them with the arrival of cold weather, and

WHEREAS, this results in a tremendous loss of productive man hours due to employees being late or absent from work, important appointments missed, and cars stalled on busy thoroughfares on remote areas, and

WHEREAS, the stranded motorist often incurs considerable expense for an emergency service call, and

WHEREAS, the car owner is not aware of the condition of his battery in most cases,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 2 - 9, 1966, as

"TEST YOUR BATTERY WEEK"

In Minnesota and urge that all batteries be checked and serviced before-- not after--starting failures occur.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fifteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six and of the State, the one hundred ninth.
