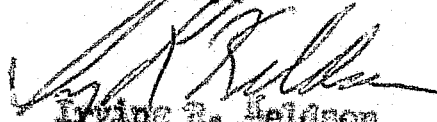
Dear Mr. Stacy:

ORDINANCE NO. 1093

EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN TO THE SOUTH
CORNERLY KNOWN AS CALVERT CEMETARY.

WHEREAS, the owners of the property hereinafter described
filed a Petition requesting the annexation of the territory
hereinafter described which was duly presented to the Council,

AND WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the
area described in the Petition and bounded as described is
less than 200 acres of unplatted land,

AND WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all the owners,

AND WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been
received from the Town Board, the County Board, or the
governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut
upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN,
MINNESOTA, DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1: The City Council hereby determines that the
annexation shall be to the best interests of the City and of
the territory affected; and that the territory described
herein abuts the City limits and is urban or suburban in
character; and that none of said territory is now included
within the limits of any city, village or borough.

SECTION 2: The Corporate limits of the City are hereby
extended to include the unplatted lands as follows, and the
same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as
effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

"All that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest
Quarter of Section 10, Township 102 North of Range 10
West, lying South of Turtle Creek, Hower County, Minne-
sota, containing 28 acres, more or less."

SECTION 3: The City Recorder is hereby directed to file
certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota
Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the County
Auditor.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance takes effect on its passage and
publishing and the filing of the certified copies as directed
in Section 3.
