

ORDINANCE NO. 101

VILLAGE OF POLY, CENTRAL COUNTY, MINNESOTA

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF POLY TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY COMPLETELY SURROUNDED AND OR BORDED ON THREE SIDES BY LANDS WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS AND ADJACENT THERETO.

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough and

WHEREAS, this territory is completely surrounded and or bordered on three sides by lands already included within the corporate limits of the village and is deemed to be urban in character;

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF POLY, CENTRAL, MINNESOTA,

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Poly, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the platted and unplatte~~d~~ territory described as follows, which territory has not heretofore been completely surrounded and or bordered on three sides by territory already included within the village limits:

1. Lots one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4), five (5), six (6), seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), and ten (10), Block Three (3), Holridge Addition to the Village of Poly.
2. Also that part of Sixth Avenue which lies immediately in front of and abutting upon such lots; also that part of the Alley adjacent to said lots.
3. The East 20 feet of the South 22 rods of the southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW^{1/4}) of Section One-hundred (100), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29).
4. The West 120.20 feet of the East 220.20 feet of the South 22 feet of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE^{1/4}) of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29).
5. Lot Twenty (20), Park Lots Addition, which is in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW^{1/4}) of Section Twenty-five (25), Township Thirteen (13), Range Twenty-nine (29).
6. Also that part of Eighth Avenue which lies immediately in front of and abutting upon said lot twenty (20), and also that part of Eighth Avenue which lies immediately in front of and abutting upon lots Twenty-one (21), Twenty-two (22), and Twenty-three (23), in Park Lots addition.
7. That part of the West Half of the Southeast Quarter (NW^{1/4}) of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29), described as follows: Beginning at a point where the right of way of the Great Northern Railroad right of way intersects the Section Line between Lots One-hundred Twenty-five (125), and Twenty-six (126), on the South side

of said plats of maps: Thence South and 90° East along said north line, thence South 147 feet, thence North to the right of way of said Great Northern Railroad Company; thence Southward along said right of way line to the place of beginning, said front containing one-half acre.

D. That part of Eighth Avenue lying and being immediately adjacent to the Great Northern Railway right of way, which is not now in the Village of Foley; That part of Grace Street as extended, which lies in Section Twenty-five (25), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29), consisting of the west section line of said Section Twenty-nine (29), and continuing northeasterly to the northeast corner of Village-Hold Edge Addition to the Village of Foley; That part of the Great Northern Railway right of way consisting of the west line of Section Twenty-five (25), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29), hence continuing in a northeasterly direction to a line which connects at the northeast corner of Village-Hold Edge Addition to the Village of Foley and runs to the northeast corner of Lot No. 10, Park Lane Addition to the Village of Foley, and there terminating; all that part of Lots One (1), One-half (1/2), Four (4) and Lots Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11), and One-half (1/2) of Lot No. 12, Park Lane Addition to the Village of Foley.

E. Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11), and One-half (1/2) of Lot No. 12, Hold Edge Addition to the Village of Foley.

F. All that part of the Norob Plat of the Southeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29), lying Northerly of Clemente Park Highway No. 23, and Easterly of Broadway Avenue, excepting Block Six (6), and Seven (7), in Hold Edge Addition to the Village of Foley, excepting therefrom, a part of land described as follows:

Commencing at the east line of Broadway Avenue and the intersection with the south right-of-way line of C. A. R. R. No. 20; thence southerly along said south right of way line a distance of 100.0 feet to a point, said point being the point of beginning; thence continuing southerly along said south right of way line of C. A. R. R. No. 20 a distance of 102.0 feet to a point; thence southeasterly and parallel to Broadway Avenue a distance of 100.0 feet to a point; thence at right angles to the last mentioned line in a northeasterly direction, a distance of 140 feet to a point; thence to the right and parallel to said Broadway Avenue a distance of 201.0 feet to a point, said point being the point of beginning.

Also excepting the following described parcels:

commencing at a point 30 feet east of east quarter corner of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29), said point being the point of beginning; thence southerly along the quarter line a distance of 200 feet; thence deflecting to the left at 90 degrees for a distance of 103.30 feet; said point being on the North right-of-way line of Trunk Highway No. 23; thence northeasterly along Trunk Highway right of way a distance of 120 feet; thence continuing along right triangle of said right of way for a distance of 130.7 feet to intersect west line of Eighth Avenue in the Village of Foley; thence northerly along west line of Eighth Avenue for a distance of 23 feet to the point of beginning.


G. That part of Broadway abutting upon Block Six (6), Hold Edge Addition to the Village of Foley, and upon that part of the North Half of the Southeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29), Range Twenty-nine (29).

12. That part of Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 25, commencing at the intersection with the center line of Broadway Avenue and continuing to the eastern boundary extended of Lot Four (4), of County Auditor's Plat B of the Southeast Quarter (180), of Section Twenty-five (25), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29).
13. That part of County Road No. 43 lying and being in Section Twenty-six (26), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29), running upon the east 200.50 feet of the South Half of the Northeast Quarter (184) of NE 1/4, Section Twenty-six (26).
14. A portion of unpaved street abutting upon the east 50 feet of the West Half (E. 50ft. of W1/2) of Lot Eleven (11), Auditor's Plat of Subdivision of Southeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter (184 of 360), Section Twenty-six (26), being 30 feet in width and 50 feet in length.
15. The north 150 feet of the south 165 feet of the east 200.5 feet of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (184 of W1/4), Section Twenty-six (26), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29).



Section 3. Effective Date of Amendment. This ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.


