
Dear Mr. Wurst:

ORDINANCE NO. 309
AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING
CERTAIN PREMISES INTO THE
CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS

The City Council of the City of Thief River Falls do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to MSA 414.03 Subd. 2 the City Council of the City of Thief River Falls determines:

Subd. 1. That a Petition for Annexation to the City of Thief River Falls has been signed and filed by all of the owners of the following described premises situated in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

Tract 1

That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-eight (28), in Township One Hundred Fifty-four (154) North, Range Forty-three (43), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, beginning at a point located Twenty-five (25) Feet directly North of the Northeast Corner of Block Five (5), in Hemmingston's Addition to Thief River Falls; thence running directly North a distance of Three Hundred Sixty (360) Feet; thence running directly West to the East line of the Great Northern Railway Right of Way line; thence running South along and following the East line of the Said Great Northern Railway Right of Way Line to a point located Twenty-five (25) Feet North of the North Boundary Line of Hemmingston's Addition; thence running directly East to the Point of Beginning following a line located Twenty-five (25) Feet North of the North Line of said Block Five (5), in said Hemmingston's Addition.

Tract 2

A tract of land 25 feet by 140 feet, situated in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-eight (28) in Township One Hundred Fifty-four (154), Range Forty-three (43), described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Block Five (5) in Hemmingsen's Addition to Thief River Falls; thence from said point of beginning running directly North 25 feet; thence West 140 feet; thence South 25 feet; thence East 140 feet to the point of beginning.

Tract 3

A tract of land located and situated in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sect. 28, T 154, R 43 W; said tract of land being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a point at the Northwest corner of Lot 5, Block 5, of Hemmingsen's Addition to Thief River Falls; thence North a distance of 25 feet; thence in a generally easterly direction to a point 25 feet directly north of the northeast corner of the said Lot 5, Block 5, Hemmingsen's Addition; thence south to the said northeast corner of Lot 5, Block 5; thence in a generally westerly direction along the north line of said Lot 5, Block 5, of Hemmingsen's Addition to Thief River Falls, to the point of beginning.

Subd. 2. That Proof of filing copies thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Board of the Town of North and the County Board of Pennington County has been furnished to the Council.

Subd. 3. That it is hereby determined that the annexation will be to the best interest of the City of Thief River Falls and of the territory affected.

Section 2. The land described in Section 1 hereof is hereby declared to be annexed to the City of Thief River Falls.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

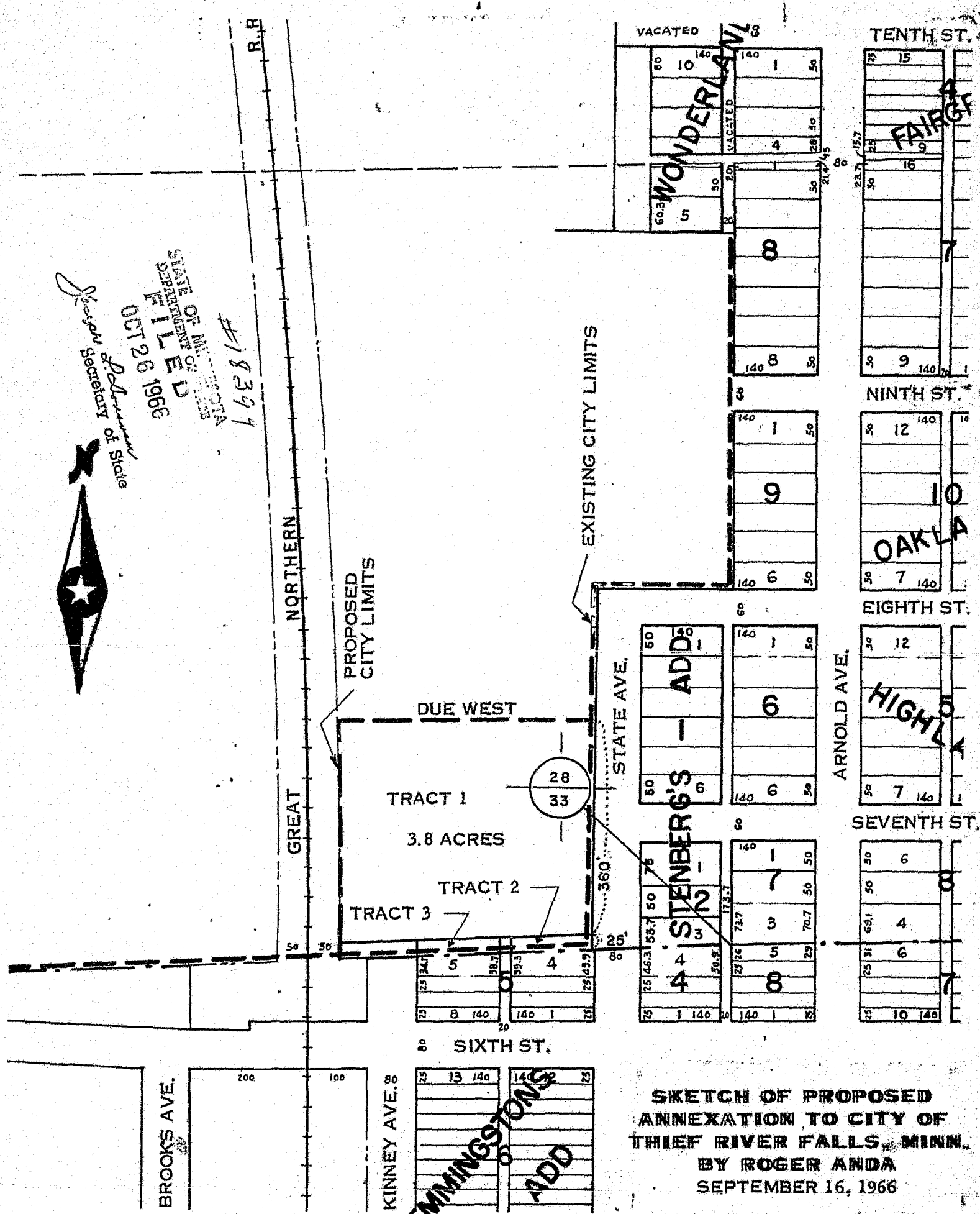
