

WHEREAS, the petition dated May 31, 1966, requesting annexation of land hereinafter described was presented to the council on June 6, 1966; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 10 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within or abuts upon the boundary of any incorporated city, village, or boroughs; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all of the owners; and

WHEREAS, copies of the said petition have been duly filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the town board of Great Bend Township and the county board of Cottonwood County, being the town and county in which all of the land proposed to be annexed is located on June 4, 1966, and June 3rd, 1966, and more than 30 days have elapsed and written objections to the annexation have not been submitted to the city by the town board or the county board and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits at the Westerly boundary thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WINDOM, MINNESOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the city and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is about to become urban in character; and (3) that none of the territory is now included within the limits of any other city, village, or borough.

Section 2. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land hereinafter described and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 3. The description of the land located in the Township of Great Bend in Cottonwood County, Minnesota, which is hereby annexed is described

as follows:

All that part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 26, Township 105 North, Range 36 West of the 5th P.M. described as follows to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 26, thence bearing North 8 degrees 19 feet West along the West line of said Southeast Quarter of said Section 26 for a distance of 821.80 feet more or less to the Southwest corner of Lot 25 of the Phil Johnson Addition to the City of Windom; thence bearing North 81 degrees 40 feet East along the South line of Lots 25 and 24 extended of said Phil Johnson Addition to the City of Windom for a distance of 320 feet; thence bearing South 8 degrees 25 feet East a distance of 127.25 feet; thence bearing North 81 degrees 34 feet East a distance of 319.90 feet; thence bearing South 8 degrees 25 feet East a distance of 691.50 feet, which said line is also the West line of Block 4 of Rolling Green Subdivision of the City of Windom and also the West line of Blocks 2 and 1 of Reeve Subdivision of the City of Windom, and which line extends to the South line of said Southeast Quarter of said Section 26 and which point on said South line of said Southeast Quarter of said Section 26 is 216 feet West of the Southwest corner of Lot 13 of Weid's First Addition to the City of Windom; thence bearing South 82 degrees 00 feet West for a distance of 637.90 feet more or less to the point of beginning, containing 10 acres more or less, subject to Highway Easements of record.


Mr. Weeks:

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WINDOM TO INCLUDE 10 ACRES OF UNPLATTED LAND ADJACENT TO THE CITY.

WHEREAS, a petition dated May 31, 1966, requesting annexation of land hereinafter described was presented to the Council on June 6, 1966; and

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 26, thence bearing North 8 degrees 19 minutes West along the West line of said Southeast Quarter of said Section 26 for a distance of 681.00 feet more or less to the Southwest corner of lot 12 of the Phil Johnson Addition to the City of Windom; thence bearing North 21 degrees 14 minutes East along the East line of lot 21 of said addition of said Phil Johnson Addition to the City of Windom for a distance of 210 feet; thence bearing South 8 degrees 25 minutes East a distance of 127.75 feet; thence bearing North 21 degrees 14 minutes East a distance of 317.50 feet; thence bearing South 8 degrees 25 minutes East a distance of 641.50 feet, which said line is also the West line of Block 4 of Rolling Green Subdivision of the City of Windom and also the West line of Block 2 of said Rolling Green Subdivision of the City of Windom, and which line extends to the line of the

Southeast Quarter of said Section 26 and which point on said South line of said Southeast Quarter of said Section 26 is 216 Feet West of the Southwest corner of lot 13 of Wold's First Addition to the City of Windom; thence bearing South 82 degrees 00 minutes West for a distance of 637.90 feet more or less to the point of beginning, containing 10 acres more or less, subject to Highway Easements of record.
