
Dear Mr. Parker:





ORDINANCE No. 141

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMBRIDGE, ISANTI COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated the 11th day of May, 1966, requesting annexation of the territory described below, was duly presented to the council and filed in the office of the Village Clerk on July 26, 1966; and

WHEREAS, said petition for annexation was signed by the Chairman and Clerk of the School Board of the petitioning School District, a municipal corporation, which municipal corporation is the sole owner of the said territory described below; and

WHEREAS, a true and correct copy of said petition for annexation was filed in the office of the Township Clerk of the Township of Cambridge on July 26, 1966, and in the office of the County Auditor in and for Isanti County, Minnesota on July 26, 1966, the said Township and County being the same in which all of the land to be annexed is located; and

WHEREAS, a true and correct copy of said petition for annexation, together with the required certificates of filing the same and the other required items, have been duly filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission on or about July 26, 1966, and copies of the Certificate of Filing have been duly mailed to the Isanti County Auditor and the Minnesota Secretary of State; and

WHEREAS, more than 30 days have elapsed since said petition and the other required papers were filed with said Minnesota Municipal Commission, and all other legal requirements as to filing and certification have been met, and no written objections to the annexation from any municipal subdivision or person, have been filed or submitted to the said Minnesota Municipal Commission or the Village of Cambridge; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that the annexation of the territory hereinafter described will be to the best interest of the municipality and of the territory affected, and that said territory is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government:

NOW THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF CAMBRIDGE ORDAINS:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that the territory described below abutts upon the Village of Cambridge and is so conditioned as to properly be subjected to Village government, and that the annexation thereof would be to the best interest of the Village of Cambridge and the territory affected.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Cambridge are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows, to-wit:

That part of the South Half of the Northeast Quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$ OF NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Thirty-six (36), Range Twenty-three (23), described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-nine (29) Township

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Thirty-six (36), Range Twenty-three (23), thence North on the Section line 880 feet, thence West parallel to the East and West Quarter line 1796.87 feet, more or less, and to the West line of Lot 45, Auditor's Subdivision No. 8, Village of Cambridge, if produced North, thence South on the last described line 880 feet and to the Northwest corner of Lot 45, Auditor's Subdivision No. 8, thence East on the Quarter line 1796.87 feet, to the point of beginning.

That there are no presently existing public or private roads or rights-of-way on or abutting said premises.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance in the Office of the Secretary of State, in the Office of the Minnesota Municipal Commission, and the Office of the Isanti County Auditor, all pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Annotated Section 414.03, as amended.

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this Ordinance have been filed as directed in Section 3, hereof.





PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMBRIDGE, ISANTI COUNTY,
MINNESOTA:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Owner of the territory hereinafter described,
heroby requests and respectfully petitions the Village Council to
annex said territory to the Village of Cambridge, and to extend
the village boundaries to include the same, and for that purpose
respectfully states:

1. That the territory to be annexed consists wholly of
unplatted lands which do not exceed 200 acres in area. That all of
said lands lie entirely within the Township of Cambridge, in the
County of Isanti and State of Minnesota, and the description of said
land is as follows, to-wit:

That part of the South Half of the Northeast Quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$
of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Thirty-six
(36), Range Twenty-three (23), described as follows, to-

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that it would be for the best interests of the undersigned and for the best interests of the Village of Cambridge if said territory were included within the Village of Cambridge and annexed thereto.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned respectfully petitions the Village Council of Cambridge, to include the land heretofore described within the boundaries of the Village of Cambridge, and to annex said territory by ordinance, in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 414.03, (2), as amended.
