

ORDINANCE No. 142

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMBRIDGE, ISANTI COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated the 20th day of July, 1966, requesting annexation of the territory described below, was duly presented to the council and filed in the office of the Village Clerk on July 26, 1966; and

WHEREAS, said petition for annexation was duly signed by all of the owners of the property described below; and

WHEREAS, a true and correct copy of said petition for annexation was filed in the office of the Township Clerk of the Township of Cambridge on July 26, 1966, and in the office of the County Auditor in and for Isanti County, Minnesota, on July 26, 1966, the said Township and County being the same in which all of the land to be annexed is located; and

WHEREAS, a true and correct copy of said petition for annexation, together with the required certificates of filing the same and the other required items, have been duly filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission on or about July 26, 1966, and copies of the Certificate of Filing have been duly mailed to the Isanti County Auditor and the Minnesota Secretary of State; and

WHEREAS, more than 30 days have elapsed since said petition and the other required papers were filed with said Minnesota Municipal Commission, and all other legal requirements as to filing and certification have been met, and no written objections to the annexation from any municipal subdivision or person have been filed or submitted to the said Minnesota Municipal Commission or the Village of Cambridge; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that the annexation of the territory hereinafter described will be to the best interest of the municipality and of the territory affected, and that said territory is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government:

NOW THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF CAMBRIDGE ORDAINS:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the Village of Cambridge and is so conditioned as to properly be subjected to Village government, and that the annexation thereof would be to the best interest of the Village of Cambridge and the territory affected.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Cambridge are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the intersection of the West line of Lot Eighty-two (82), Auditor's Subdivision Number Eight (8) of the Village of Cambridge, and the North plat line of Sunset Knoll, a recorded plat in the Village of Cambridge (said North plat line also being the center line of 5th Avenue N.W., a village street), thence West along the North plat line of Sunset Knoll, 426 feet, more or less, to the Northwest corner of

Lot One (1), Block Two (2), Sunset Knoll; thence continuing West on an extension West of the North plat line of Sunset Knoll, 40 feet; thence North parallel to the West line of Outlot One (1), Rippeys Addition to the Village of Cambridge, 451.9 feet; thence East and parallel to the North plat line of Sunset Knoll, 466 feet, more or less and to the West line of Lot Eighty-two (82), Auditor's Subdivision Number Eight (8); thence South on the West line of said Lot Eighty-two (82), Auditor's Subdivision Number Eight (8), 451.9 feet to the place of commencement and there to terminate, including the public road abutting said premises described as a strip of land 33 feet in width North of and adjacent to 5th Avenue N.W., as said 5th Avenue N.W. is dedicated in the recorded plat of Sunset Knoll.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance in the Office of the Secretary of State, in the Office of the Minnesota Municipal Commission, and the Office of the Isanti County Auditor, all pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Annotated Section 414.03, as amended.

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this Ordinance have been filed as directed in Section 3, hereof.

PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMBRIDGE, ISANTI COUNTY,
MINNESOTA:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Owners of the territory hereinafter described,
heroby request and respectfully petition the Village Council to
annex said territory to the Village of Cambridge, and to extend
the village boundaries to include the same, and for that purpose
respectfully states:

1. That the territory to be annexed consists wholly of
unplatted lands which do not exceed 200 acres in area. That all of
said lands lie entirely within the Township of Cambridge, in the
County of Isanti and State of Minnesota, and the description of said
land is as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the intersection of the West line of Lot
Eighty-two (82), Auditor's Subdivision Number Eight (8)
of the Village of Cambridge, and the North plat line of
Sunset Knoll, a recorded plat in the Village of Cambridge
(said North plat line also being the center line of 5th
Avenue N.W., a village street), thence West along the
North plat line of Sunset Knoll, 426 feet, more or less,
to the Northwest corner of Lot One (1), Block Two (2),
Sunset Knoll; thence continuing West on an extension
West of the North plat line of Sunset Knoll, 40 feet;
thence North parallel to the West line of Outlet One (1),
Rippeys Addition to the Village of Cambridge, 451.9 feet;
thence East parallel to the North plat line of Sunset
Knoll, 456 feet, more or less and to the West line of
Lot Eighty-two (82), Auditors Subdivision Number Eight (8);
thence South on the West line of said Lot Eighty-two (82),
Auditor's Subdivision Number Eight (8), 451.9 feet to the
place of commencement and there to terminate, excepting a
strip of land 33 feet in width North of and adjacent to
5th Avenue N.W., as the same is dedicated in the recorded
plat of said Sunset Knoll.

That there is a public road abutting said premises, de-
scribed as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land 33 feet in width North of and adjacent to
5th Avenue N.W., as said 5th Avenue N.W. is dedicated in
the recorded plat of Sunset Knoll.

That said public road is an integral part of said territory heretofore described and it would be for the best interests of the Village of Cambridge and these petitioners if said road were annexed to the Village of Cambridge, in addition to the property heretofore described.

That your petitioners hereby request that said public road be annexed along with said territory heretofore described.

1. That the territory described above, abuts upon the Village of Cambridge limits and none of it is presently a part of any incorporated city, village or borough.

2. That all of said territory is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to municipal government, and the undersigned believe that it would be for the best interests of the undersigned and for the best interests of the Village of Cambridge if said territory were included within the Village of Cambridge and annexed thereto.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned respectfully petition the Village Council of Cambridge, to include the land heretofore described within the boundaries of the Village of Cambridge, and to annex said territory by ordinance, in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 414.03, (2), as amended.
