

PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, it is of vital interest to all citizens of the United States of America that we possess a sound National Defense, and
- WHEREAS, it is well known that our Navy and Marine Corps are making great contributions to the security of our Nation and free men everywhere, and
- WHEREAS, the mobile forces of the Navy manned by highly trained and dedicated personnel provide a deterrent force virtually free from surprise attack, and
- WHEREAS, since 1922, October 27th has been celebrated nationally and locally as Navy Day, a day on which it is only fitting and proper that the citizens of this Nation give well deserved honor and recognition to the achievements of our Navy and particularly to its heroic men and women - living and dead - all over the world, for their patriotism, loyalty, efficiency and devotion to duty.

HON. THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim Thursday, October 27, 1966 as

"NAVY DAY"

in Minnesota and call upon all citizens of Minnesota to take part in appropriate observance of this day through the many channels open to them.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six and of the State, the one hundred ninth.
