WHEREAS, members are aided in mastering the art of effective public speaking; helped in making a poised appearance before an audience, and provided with enjoyable fellowship and a forum for the stimulating exchange of ideas,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Solvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 29 - November 4, 1966 as

"TOASTMASTERS WEEK"

in Minnesota, in recognition of this outstanding and worthwhile organization.
