
Dear Mr. Grover:

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, MINNESOTA, DECLARING THE LAND TO WHICH IT SHALL BE ATTACHED, AND EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS TO ENCOMPASS SAID LAND.

WHEREAS, Reinhold and Lydia Roth, have filed with the City Council a petition stating that they are the sole owners of the hereinafter described property lying and being in the County of Douglas, Township of Alexandria, and State of Minnesota; that said land abuts upon the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria and is unplatted and does not exceed two hundred (200) acres in area and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Alexandria has examined said petition, and has determined the facts therein stated to be true, and that said property is so conditioned as property to be subjected to municipal government, and that the annexation of said property would be in the best interests of the municipality and of the territory to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 414.03 notice of said annexation petition have been filed with Douglas County, Alexandria Township and the Minnesota Municipal Commission, and it further appearing that no objection have been filed within the time prescribed by law,

NOW THEREFORE,

The City Council of the City of Alexandria does ordain:

SECTION I. That it is in the best interests of the City of Alexandria and the territory hereinafter described that said territory be annexed to and be made a part of the municipality of the City of Alexandria.

SECTION II. That the following described land, to-wit:

That part of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$), of Section Thirty (30), Township One Hundred Twenty-eight (128) North, Range Thirty-seven (37) West described as follows:

Commencing at the center of said Section 30, thence north along the North-South quarter line to the center line of 18th Avenue extended; thence east along the center line of 18th Avenue to the center line of Hawthorne Street; thence north along the center line of Hawthorne Street to the center line of 17th Avenue; thence east along the center line of 17th Avenue extended to the west line of Jefferson Street; thence south along the west line of Jefferson Street extended and along the west line of that certain tract of land conveyed to Independent School District 206 by deed dated June 15, 1966, and recorded in Book 90 of Deeds, page 386, to the southwest corner of said tract; thence east along the

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South line of said tract conveyed to said Independent School District No. 206 to the southeast corner of said tract; thence south along the east line of said tract extended to the East-West quarter line of said Section 30; thence west along the East-West quarter line of said Section 30 to the center of said Section 30, said point being the place of beginning, containing 63 acres more or less, subject to highway easements of record,

is hereby annexed to and made a part of the municipality of the City of Alexandria, and the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria, Minnesota, shall be and the same hereby are extended to include and encompass the land and territory above described.

SECTION III. All of said land and territory described by limits, descriptions and boundaries in Section II above and hereby annexed to and made a part of the City of Alexandria, Minnesota, shall be and do hereby become a part of the 4th Ward of the City of Alexandria.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota, the charter of the City of Alexandria, and upon the filing of a copy of this Ordinance with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the auditor of Douglas County, Minnesota, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
