WHEREAS, Minnesota is a year-around playground, attractive in all seasons of the year, and

WHEREAS, winter, which has just begun in Minnesota, opens up a host of scenic and sports wonders, and

WHEREAS, the primary winter sport of skiing is now supplemented by a growing interest in all other winter activities, and

WHEREAS, the development of winter sports is of great economic value to the entire state, and

WHEREAS, an increasing number of Minnesotans and visitors to our state are learning the joy of all types of snow sports,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 23, 1966, as

"THE OPENING OF WINTER SPORTS SEASON"

In Minnesota and urge all citizens to enjoy to the fullest extent winter in Minnesota.
