An Ordinance Annexing to the City of Rochester, Minnesota, Certain Unplatted Land Not Exceeding Two Hundred Acres in Area, All Being in the Southwest Quarter of Section Twenty-Seven, Township One Hundred Seven, North, Range Fourteen West, Olmsted County, Minnesota,

The Common Council of the City of Rochester do ordain:
Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Rochester, signed by all the owners of the land described herein, requesting the Common Council to annex said land to the City of Rochester.
