AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WARREN TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Warren, Ninnesota, by the sole owners of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of Warren, Minnesota:

Commencing at the morthwest corner of Section Six (6), Township One Hundred Fifty-four (154) North of Range Forty-seven (47) West; thence due south clong the west section line of Section 6 for a distance of 75 feet to the true point of beginning; thence easterly along a line parallel to the morth section line of Section Six (6) for a distance of 590 feet; thence acutherly along a line parallel to the west section line of Section 6 to the intersection of St. Paul, Minneapolia and Sault Ste.
