AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLACE OF LONG PRAIRIE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, PLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain potition, deted September 20, 1966, requesting annoxation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on the 3rd day of October, 1966, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is loss than two hundred (200) acres of platted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or horough, and

WHEREAS, the potition was signed by all of the owners of said land, and WHEREAS, no objections to the amenation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the lands to be amered, and

Whiereas, a copy of said petition was filed with the Aunicipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the County Auditor of Todd County, and the Town Clerk of Long Prairie Township, on October 7, 1966, and

The Council of the Village of Long Frairie, Minnesota, ordains: Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines:

- (a) That the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village, and of the territory affected.
- (b) That the territory described herein abute upon the Village limits and is urban or suburban in character.
- (c) That none of the territories are now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory America. The corporate limits of the Village are increby extended to include the platted lend described as follows, and the same is hereby america to and included in the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Lote One (1). Two (2) and Three (3) Fortmann's Subdivision, and that part of Sixth Street Southeast abutting thereon.
Lote Seven (7) through fifteen (15). Block One (1) Lakeside Addition to the Village of Long Frairie, together with that part of Fourth Street South abutting thereon, and that part of the public alley abutting thereon and located to the vest thereof.
