
SUBJECT: Minnesota Annotation A-221

ORDINANCE NO. 88

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF
THE VILLAGE OF LINDSTROM, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE
CERTAIN PLATTED LAND ABUTTING THE VILLAGE LIMITS

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated April 26, 1966, requesting annexation of certain territory was duly presented to the Council on the ²⁶th day of April, 1966, and

WHEREAS, an amended petition dated May 11, 1966, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on the 14th day of July, 1966, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the amended petition and bounded as described is approximately 16 acres of platted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all of the owners of the land proposed to be annexed as hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the Village limits at the northerly boundary thereof; and

WHEREAS, copies of said Petition have been filed with the Municipal Commission the Town Board of the Town of Chisago Lake, and the Chisago County Board of County Commissioners, said Town and County being the Town and County in which all of the land proposed to be annexed is located, and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of no other municipality abut upon the boundaries of the land to be so annexed, and

WHEREAS, no written objections to said annexation have been submitted to the Municipal Commission or the Village of Lindstrom by the Chisago Lake Town Board or the Chisago County Board of Commissioners within thirty (30) days after said filing and the time allowed pursuant to law, and

WHEREAS, no petition for incorporation or annexation is pending before the Municipal Commission including all or any part of the land proposed to be annexed and herein described;

The Council of the Village of Lindstrom, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village Limits and is urban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any incorporated city, village or borough and is platted.

Section 2. Territory annexed. The corporate limits of the Village are hereby extended to include the platted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

All those parts of Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) of Block One (1) of Andrews Beach, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for Chicago County, Minnesota, which lie in Gov't Lot Six (6), Township 34, Range 20.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor of Chicago County, Minnesota.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3.
