

As conclusions of law, the Court finds;

I. That said contestant, Emil Braun, at the General Election, held in and for said Wilkin County, on November 8th, 1910, was duly elected to the office of County Commissioner, Third Commissioner District, of said Wilkin County, for the term commencing January 2nd 1911, and is entitled to all the rights and privileges of said office, and to have and hold the same as provided by law.

II. That the decision, statement and returns of the County Canvassing Board of said County, declaring said John A. Falla, to have received the highest number of votes, and elected to said office, be and the same is hereby reversed, set aside and vacated, and the said Emil Braun is hereby declared elected to said office and said return is hereby ordered corrected so as to read that the said Emil Braun having received the highest number of votes for said office of County Commissioner, is declared elected to said office, the said Emil Braun having received 93 votes for said office.

III. That the Auditor of said Wilkin County, is hereby authorized and directed to issue to said contestant, Emil Braun, a certificate of election to said office of County Commissioner, Third Commissioners District of Wilkin County Minnesota, for the term commencing January 2nd, 1911.

IV. That the said contestant, Emil Braun is entitled to Judgement against said contestee John A. Falla, for his costs and disbursements herein, Let Judgement be entered accordingly, Dated at Breckenridge, Minnesota, December 16th, A. D. 1910, By the Court,


