
To the Honorable, the Secretary of State,

Mr. John E. Lindberg, of North Branch, a Creamery Inspector with the State Dairy & Food Commission, has this day been removed from the service by the State Dairy & Food Commissioner.

The reasons for this removal are as follows:

On the 30th day of January, 1918, the Minnesota Public Safety Commission passed the following resolution: "That the Commission go on record recommending the removal of the said John E. Lindberg".

Upon recommendation of the late Attorney General an investigation has been carried on by the State Dairy & Food Commissioner. This investigation reveals the fact that the said John E. Lindberg is incompetent and has failed to discharge the duties devolving upon him in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Commission.
