The duly qualified and acting Clerk of the Village of Cokato, Wright County, Minnesota, does hereby certify that the following question was duly placed on the ballot at the Village election held on December 6, 1966:

> "Shall Optional Plan A modifying the standard plan of village government by providing for the appointment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor be adopted for the government of the village?"

The results of the election on the question as set forth above are as follows:
