

ORDINANCE NO. 104

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE FIRST TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER AS THE ELECTION DATE FOR THE VILLAGE ELECTION.

The Village Council of the Village of Cook ordains:

Section 1: The Village Council of the Village of Cook hereby establishes the first Tuesday after the First Monday in November as the date for the annual Village election.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be effective to establish election day for year 1966 on the 8th day of November, 1966, and shall continue until this ordinance is revoked.

Section 3: This ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.
