PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the United States Jaycees is an organization of young men dedicated to community betterment and individual development, and

WHEREAS, in Minnesota there are over 160 local chapters and over 7,000 members, active in such areas as agriculture, community development, health, safety, conservation, international relations, religious activities, governmental affairs, youth in sports and mental health, and

WHEREAS, through the Jaycees, many opportunities are open for young men between the ages of 21 and 35 to be of service to their communities while developing leadership ability, and

WHEREAS, membership is open to all young men to learn "that service to humanity is the best work of life," and

WHEREAS, the civic business and service organizations of this State recognize that the Jaycees of Minnesota have contributed materially to the betterment of this State,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LoVander, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 15-21, 1967, to be

"JAYCEE WEEK"

in Minnesota, and encourage young men interested in such service and personal development to join their local Jaycee chapter.
